Focus on WISE: Strategies for Making Connections and Bringing Data to Life

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – It is challenging to ask families to do more. Wraparound Intensive Services [WISE] commitment takes a lot of time. – It was suggested attending other committees to learn of ideas that help engage families' time. – It was suggested to design a listening forum with providers. This will give feedback of what can attract WISE families to YFC. A few attendees that had participated in WISE provided feedback. Families didn't learn about YFC until after discharge or by connecting with Childrens Long term Inpatient [CLIP]. There should be a common voice within WISE to let families know of this committee. Once families started to engage in WISE they felt more time was available. – A benefit of having a connection between WISE and YFC is hearing about the barriers directly from WISE families before the barrier becomes more challenging. – WISE discharge planners can offer YFC as a platform for families to join. – Rebranding YFC orientation can help individuals understand the meaningfulness of YFC. – The WISE data doesn't speak to real time barriers. The CANS is a good starting point but shouldn't be the golden point. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – YFC completes a needs assessment. The assessment can be formatted to incorporate feedback from WISE families. The assessment is given to the state. The state can be aware of the needs of WISE families through the assessment. – YFC flyers will be given to WISE Managers who have attended this meeting.
