ADVOCACY EMAILS

- Email your elected officials directly this is important if a bill you are watching makes it all the way to the floor of the House or the Senate.
- Email specific committees directly as bills move forward, they go through different committees hearing testimony. The most effective way to advocate is to follow the bill updates and send emails directly to the committee in relation to the hearing at hand.







EMAIL DETAILS

- Send email directly to the addresses of all committee members as well as both the partisan caucus staff and the nonpartisan staff.
- All legislative emails follow this format: <u>firstname.lastname@leg.wa.gov</u>
- All staff and elected official emails are here: <u>https://leg.wa.gov</u>
- Email all parties at once in the same email if a legislator replies, it will flag it in the other members' inboxes


GOOD TO KNOW:

BE READY TO TELL YOUR STORY IN TWO MINUTES

SEND AN EMAIL EVEN IF YOU PLAN TO TESTIFY – SOMETIMES THERE ARE SO MANY PEOPLE PRESENT THAT YOU WON'T GET THE CHANCE!

IF YOU DO GIVE TESTIMONY, MENTION YOUR EMAIL SO THAT LEGISLATORS KNOW TO LOOK FOR IT
